Eligibility

All dogs entered in NAVHDA tests must be NAVHDA registered. Register or renew at WWW.NAVHDA.ORG. Dogs are eligible for Natural Ability testing up to and including the day they reach 16 months of age. Dogs over 16 months of age may be run for evaluation and only if space is available. No prize classification can be awarded a dog run for evaluation regardless of the score attained.

Entries:

Register for this test online at WWW.NAVHDA.ORG by logging into your Member Portal. Once completed, the registration form will be forwarded by email to both yourself and the Test Secretary. Test entries are limited and will be taken on a first come, first served basis subject to the rules of eligibility stated above. **WAIT FOR APPROVAL FROM THE TEST SECRETARY BEFORE PAYING FOR YOUR TEST TO ENSURE THERE IS SPACE AVAILABLE.** Online payment is preferred and can be made at WWW.SOMNNAVHDA.ORG. Alternatively, checks payable to “**Southern Minnesota NAVHDA**” can be mailed to the Test Secretary once your test entry is approved.

****Refund Policy****
